16/20. Grant Applications.

1. A grant application was received from Maen Alaw, requesting support of £500 to assist with food provisions for people suffering hardship.
RESOLVED: to award a grant of £500 subject receipt of written confirmation that some meals/food is provided free of charge. The Council also requested that it be made known that meals paid for by this grant were supported by PTC.
2. A request for support was received from Allison Watson who, together with another resident, has been manufacturing PPE, which has been donated to NHS, Care Homes and key workers. The application requested between £400a and £600. How much?
RESOLVED: to award up to £600 to Allison Watson on submissions of receipts.
3. An application for assistance was received from St Gwynan's Pre-school for £304.58 to assist with additional health & safety requirements for staff and children, especially PPE and cleaning materials. Following a full and open discussion, which included a debate of whether this application conforms to the eligibility of the support grant.
RESOLVED: to approve the grant as a one-off payment. It was decided that this application is within the spirit of the guidelines and by assisting the pre-school, this could benefit parent/s to return to work, which would be beneficial to the local economy.
