ANNUAL MEETING

Held at Penmaenmawr Council Chamber

1. Election of Town Mayor for the Municipal Year 2022/2023

Cllr Chris Williams was proposed as Mayor for 2022/23. Council voted unanimously in favour of Cllr C. Williams. The former Mayor presented the new Mayor with her chain of office.

2. Installation of the new mayor and signing of the declaration of acceptance of office

Cllr C. Williams read and signed the declaration of office.

3. Welcome to all returning and new councillors

4. Apologies for absence: Cllr S. Banwell (away)

5. Address by the former Mayor

Former Cllr K. Beard stated she was proud of the achievements and accomplishments of the Council over the last 18 months during a tremulous time. The largest achievement was the securing of the WEFO grant funding to invest on the promenade. The upcoming jubilee event will be enhanced by the works carried out. Parc Plas Mawr has also been an achievement and a notable improvement. With the addition of the Shoal project, a significant amount of work has been completed. The retiring Mayor gave her best wishes to the new Councillors and thanked everyone for giving her the opportunity to serve the community and wished the new Mayor the best of luck.

6. Address by the New Mayor

Mayor C. Williams expressed how proud he felt at the honour of being voted into the post. Testament was given to both of the previous Mayors for their dedication and achievements. Cllr C. Williams thanked Cllr. Abbott for her steadfast leadership and thanked retiring Mayor, K. Beard for her leadership through Covid and all the

achievements over the last term. Cllr. C Williams welcomed the new Councillors and welcomed back the existing and wished all the Council the best for the upcoming term.

7. Election of Deputy – Mayor for the municipal year 2022 – 2023

Two names were put forward for the role of Deputy Mayor. The Council voted in favour of deferring the Deputy Mayor election until the next meeting.

8. Installation of the new deputy mayor and signing of the declaration of acceptance of office

The Council voted to defer this matter to the next meeting.

9. To appoint representatives to outside bodies

The Council voted to defer to the next meeting.

10. To confirm an appointment to committees

The Council voted to appoint Councillors for the Promenade committee.

The following Councillors were appointed, Cllr M. Bains, Cllr U. Abbott, Cllr J. Sharples and Cllr M. Brewer.

Council voted to defer all other committees until the next meeting.

A promenade committee meeting will occur Wednesday 18th 10 am.

11. To approve the 2022 – 2023 schedule of meetings

The Council voted in favour of the schedule of meetings with the caveat that additional meetings can be held if required.

12. Adoption of standing orders

It was resolved to accept the current version of the model Standing Orders amended, where necessary, to reflect the requirements of Penmaenmawr Town Council.

13. Deferment of Other Business

It was resolved to defer all regular business until the next meeting

14. Conclusion of Meeting

It was announced that the next scheduled meeting will take place on the 31st of May at 6.30 pm. The meeting was concluded, and Councillors were invited to enjoy some light refreshments, supplied by the new Mayor, while photographs were taken.
