The parameters of the CCBC Resilience Grant was circulated to members for their information. This grant allows for applications of up to 80% of projects costs of rejuvenating businesses in the area, up to a maximum of £10,000 (with the remaining 20% supplied by the Town Council). Initial ideas for projects where discussed.

RESOLVED: To Liaise with local Businesses to Ascertain How Best to Assist them.

50/20 To Discuss Appreciation of Local Volunteers.

Building on the discussions begun at the last meeting (item 42/20), it was reported that two Special Citizens Awards have been prepared and printed and are awaiting presentation. Details of the name for the third award have not yet been received.

It was reported that the Food Bank have used ten volunteers during the crisis, adding to the eight drivers and four kitchen staff and three regular workers, who have assisted Maen Alaw.

RESOLVED: To present donations to these two organizations which equated to about £50 per volunteer, with a suggestion that these grants be used to present gift vouchers to each volunteer as a form of thanks for their dedication and hard work.
