Minutes of the Penmaenmawr Town Council COVID-19 Support Grant Committee meeting.
Held remotely online via Zoom on 17th December at 5.30 pm.

110/20. Last Meeting

- a. The minutes of the meeting of the 8th December was ratified following one minor amendment to Minutes 104/20, which should read 'further benches to be bought'.
- b. The minutes of the meeting of the 8th of December was approved as correct.
- c. Matters arising from the meeting of the 8th December,
 - i. It was reported that the umbrellas have been ordered through a local supplier. The cost was £372 (ex VAT). Three automatic, free-standing, hand gel dispenser have also been ordered for £240 (ex VAT). Four containers of 5 ltr of hospital quality hand gel had also been purchased.
 - ii. CCBC grant – The committee were advised that both Llanfairfechan and Conwy community councils were also having difficulty getting a response for CCBC regarding their TRI grants.
 - iii. Canopies – with the decision to suspend the fixed canopied from the project, the committee discussed the advantages and challenges of retractable canopies, which included aesthetic blending, permission from the property freeholder and article 4 as some properties were in the conservation area. It was decided to research this option further.

111/20. Rainbow Benches. The committee was advised that a local contractor had been identified to supply recycled plastic benches, which were maintenance-free, burn resistance and jet washable the supplier was willing to paint the benches whatever colour the Council wished. The cost of the basic benches was £280 (ex VAT), while the curved cost £490 (ex VAT).

RESOLVED: to purchase 12 benches. Once the current crisis was over these benches could be relocated to each of the play parks, one in the dingle, one in Brundits wharf.

Action: Clerk to order and to research a longer bench for outside Llys Clwyd.

112/20. Any Other Business.

- i. The committee was advised that Rev. Rosie Dymond, was attempting to organize a Nativity Painting on the wall of the Dwygyfylchi Parish Hall but was struggling to afford the resources.

RESOLVED: to award the project a £200 grant.
