Minutes of the Penmaenmawr Town Council COVID-19 Support Grant Committee meeting held remotely, via Zoom, on the 8th December at 6.00 pm.

102/20. Matters Arising from the Last Meeting.

i. Canopies.

Details of the options for fixed canopy designs had been pre-circulated. Prices ranged from £11,000 to £25,000 for four fixed canopies, some of which required securing to the pavement, while others were free-standing. It was also reported that the lead-in time for such canopies was around 8 – 10 weeks, meaning that most of the winter will be over before the canopies will be fitted.

RESOLVED: to suspend this project due to the cost and lead-in time of fixed canopies and fragility of awning canopies.

103/20. Update on CCBC grant.

It was reported that the Council is still waiting for an update on the situation regarding CCBC TRI grant. Following the decision of 102/20 above the possibility to amending the grant was discussed. It was proposed to increase the number of benches requested and to include large 'golf style' umbrellas, which could be positioned outside shops where queues gather.

RESOLVED: to spend up to £800 on PTC branded umbrellas.

104/20 Rainbow Bench

Potential designs for a rainbow bench had been pre-circulated. It was proposed that one of these benches could be located in each of the areas play parks and that this project could be included in the CCBC TRI grant (103/20 above).

RESOLVED: To purchase ten rainbow benches one to be located in each of the play parks, subject to approval within CCBC TRI grant and further benches to be bought and located in other open spaces.

105/20. Any Other Business.

i. It was proposed to introduce a community award scheme, which would include a monthly draw. This item was deferred to the next meeting due to time constraints.
