



PENMAENMAWR TOWN COUNCIL GO VOLUNTEER GRANT SCHEME

Our Go Volunteer Scheme is for 16 to 25 year old Penmaenmawr residents who wish to volunteer on overseas placements and are seeking financial assistance to cover the costs of flights, accommodation and inoculations. As a town council, we wish to help you gain worthwhile skills that will benefit you and your communities in your lives, and we will acknowledge this by providing up to £1000 for such purposes.

THE RULES

1. The maximum level of funding will be £1000 for any one applicant.
2. The only costs you can claim under this scheme are for flights, accommodation and inoculations.
3. Flights and accommodation costs will be paid directly to the service providers by Penmaenmawr Town Council. You will be expected to find reasonable quotations for these costs.
4. If you are successful in your application, you will attend a meeting with the Town Clerk who will purchase the flights and accommodation in your presence. Please ensure that you have all necessary documentation when the bookings are made, such as passport, visa(s), inoculation certificate(s), etc.
5. Inoculation costs are to be billed directly to Penmaenmawr Town Council by the respective health body. It is your responsibility to ensure that whoever is inoculating you is prepared to do this.
6. Penmaenmawr Town Council reserves the right to restrict successful award applications to £3000 in any one financial year.
7. Full terms and conditions can be found on the website.

Please note that any financial support from Penmaenmawr Town Council must be acknowledged on all publicity material including printed, digital and broadcast media.

Penmaenmawr Town Council reserves the right not to exercise the Go Volunteer Scheme offer if either the rules or the criteria have not been adhered to.

All applications must be made on the respective official application forms, which are available on the Penmaenmawr Town Council website, along with guidelines and full terms and conditions.

These guidelines for the Go Volunteer Grants Scheme supersedes all other guidelines issued.
